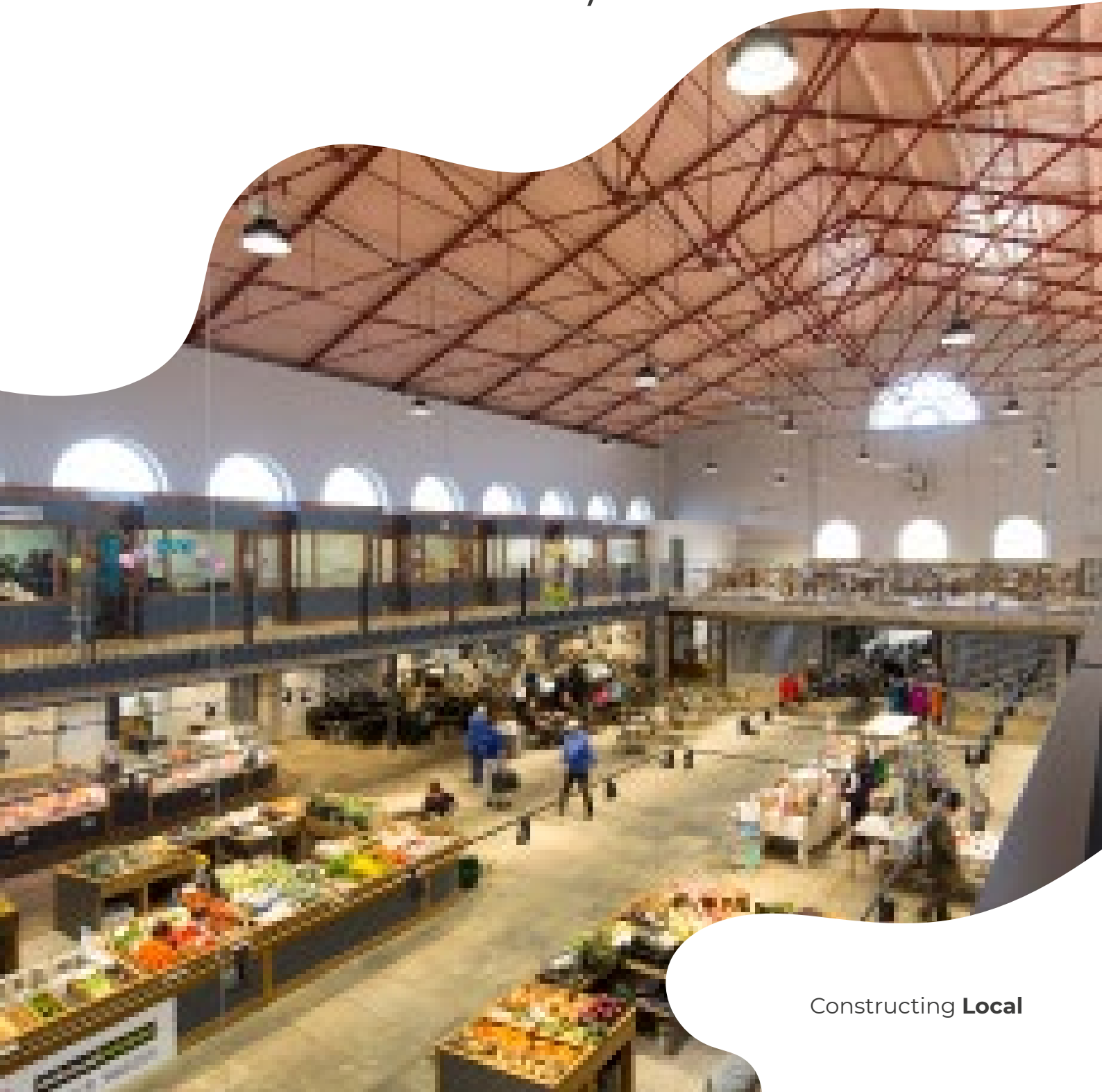

Scarborough Market

Dating back to 1853, Scarborough Market is an iconic building in Scarborough town.

Work began to refurbish and extend the current hall, providing a larger and more inviting area for residents to source high quality local food items, whilst supporting small Scarborough based businesses.

Get into STEM

Added Value delivered the 'Get into STEM' kit into Friarage Primary School (0.1 miles from site) for a 2 week period in October 2015.

Apprentices

Two groups of students from Friarage Primary School (located directly opposite the market) visited the site on Friday 14th October including a group of reception and year one students and a group containing members of the school council. Both groups were introduced in the site cabin to site safety rules before putting on their PPE and venturing for a look around the construction site via safe walkways.

The Marketing team at Scarborough Council also visited the site and were shown around by the site manager. We worked with Futureworks Yorkshire to use one of their apprentices for a 20 week period in Joinery.

Work Experience

We offered 6 work experience placements in trades from bricklaying to joinery and quantity surveying. One work experience placement secured paid work on site as a result of his impressive efforts during his work experience. 30 days of work experience was carried out from students in groundworks, bricklaying, joinery and quantity surveying.



Charitable Proposition

Scarborough Jobmatch was awarded £1000 through our Esh Communities programme. This enables them to support people to find work and pay for training such as CSCS tests and cards.

This money was used to put seven people through a three day H&S Course and take their CSCS test.
